Dear Parent:

Good vision is important to your child's education. That's why we will be checking your child's vision at school this year.

The vision test is very simple. Your child will be asked to read a line of letters on an eye chart while standing at a distance. Children age 9 and younger will also be asked to play the "magic glasses game". This is a test to determine if the eyes are working together. This will take about 5 minutes.

Sometimes children have trouble seeing, and they do not even know it. If this is the only way they have ever seen things, it seems normal to them. We would like your child to do well in school. If they cannot see well, it can be more difficult for them.

We will let you know if we find a possible problem with your child's vision. We may ask you to take your child to an eye doctor for an examination. If for any reason, you are unable to financially arrange an eye examination, please contact me. If we do not find a problem with your child's vision, you will not receive a letter.
