

## Adult Vision Screening Set-Up

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The screening location should, ideally, be a quiet, well-lit environment larger than 12 feet by 15 feet.

### You will need:

- Distance and Near Visual Acuity Charts
- Registration/Risk Assessment Forms
- A blank wall to hang the distance chart with room to measure straight back ten feet.
- 1-2 tables and 2-6 chairs
- Trash can
- 3-pronged outlet if you are using a machine to screen
- Clipboards or a hard surface
- Pens
- Pointer (optional)
- Masking or painter's tape
- Anti-bacterial wipes-for near charts

### Registration

- Set –up table with two chairs
- Place registration forms, pens, and clip boards on the table

### Distance Acuity Screening

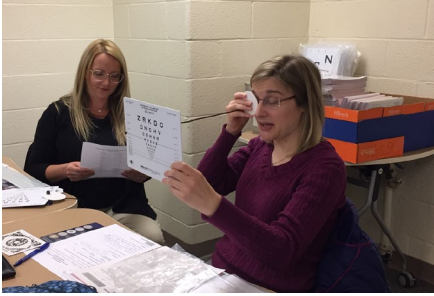
#### Hanging the ETDRS Wall Chart

- Tape chart using masking or painters tape to a light, uncluttered wall.
- The 20/40 line should be 48 inches from the floor.
- Avoid walls near windows if possible
- Measure a distance of 10 feet from the wall chart and place a line on the floor with masking tape. This is where the subject will stand with their heels on the tape.



Place pens, alcohol wipes and occluder or small disposable cups (to be used as an occluder) on a table.

## Near Acuity Screening



Place two chairs at a table (screening can also be done standing, but seated may be more comfortable)  
Put the near chart, cheat sheet, anti-bacterial wipes, and alcohol swabs on the table.

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### **Exit interview-can be seated or standing**

Put two chairs, pens, stapler, results form, and educational brochures on the table.
