She's Michael's big sister and is sharing tips with him throughout the book.





"Today, you go to the eye doctor!"




"Don't get your toothbrush in my eye," Michael told Megan. "Eyes are very delicate."



"My eyes are hazel," said Megan. "My eyes are blue," said Michael. "Eyes can be blue, green, hazel, brown, and many other colors."




"I wear glasses all the time to help me see," Michael said.





Help Michael and Megan find their way to better vision! Draw a line from each of them to the eye chart.




Parts of the Eye



Be careful when you play sports like baseball.




