Global Sight Initiative – Purpose & Goal



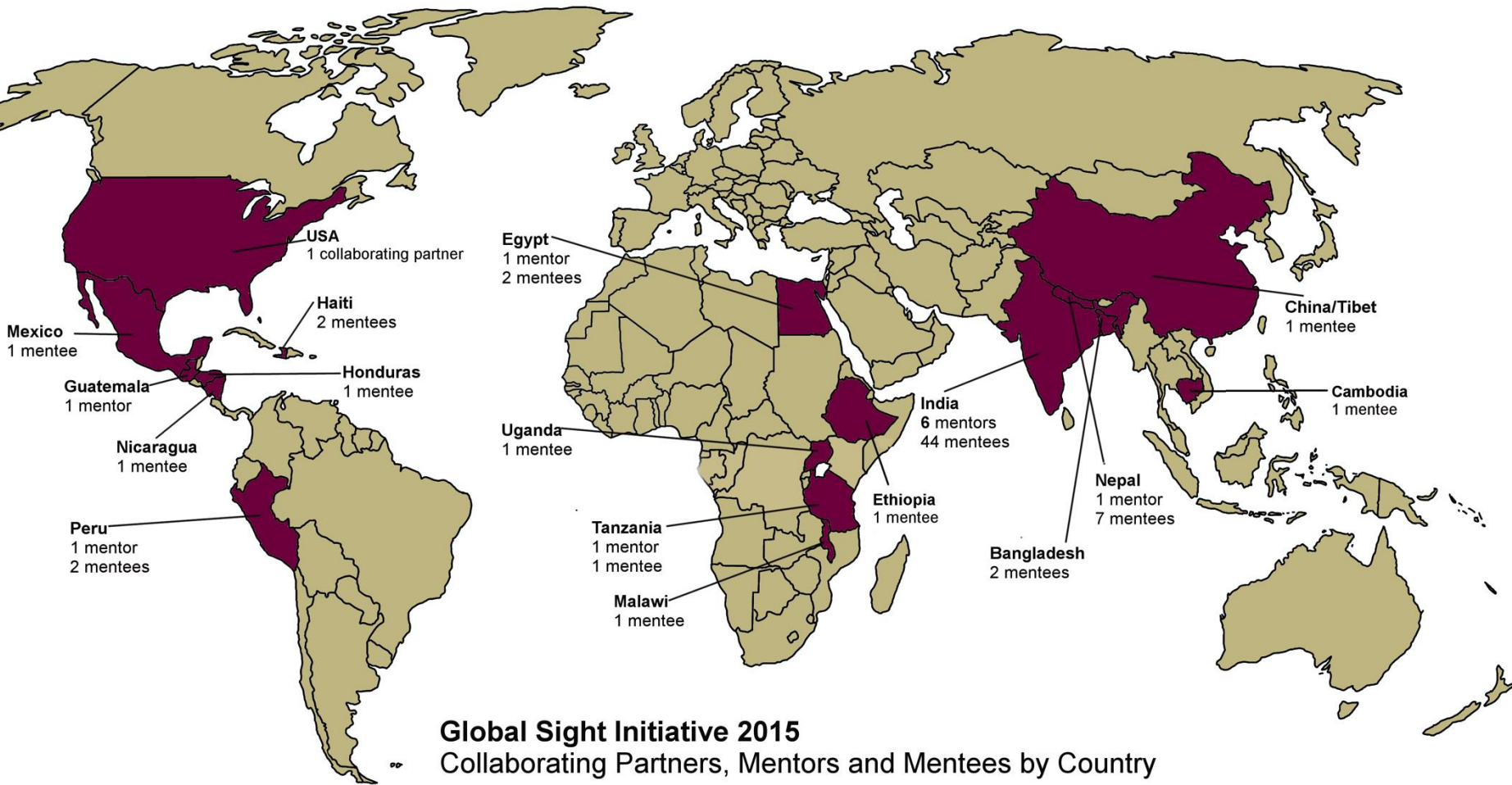
Purpose:

- Build a global network among Mentor institutions for mutual strengthening of planning, training, mentoring, research, and advocacy
- Establish & share preferred practices
- Focus: high quality, high volume, sustainable eye care services
- Capacity building as core strategy

Goal:

- To engage at least 100 eye hospitals to perform at least one million additional cataract surgeries annually within a sustainable framework by 2020.

Global Sight Initiative Network



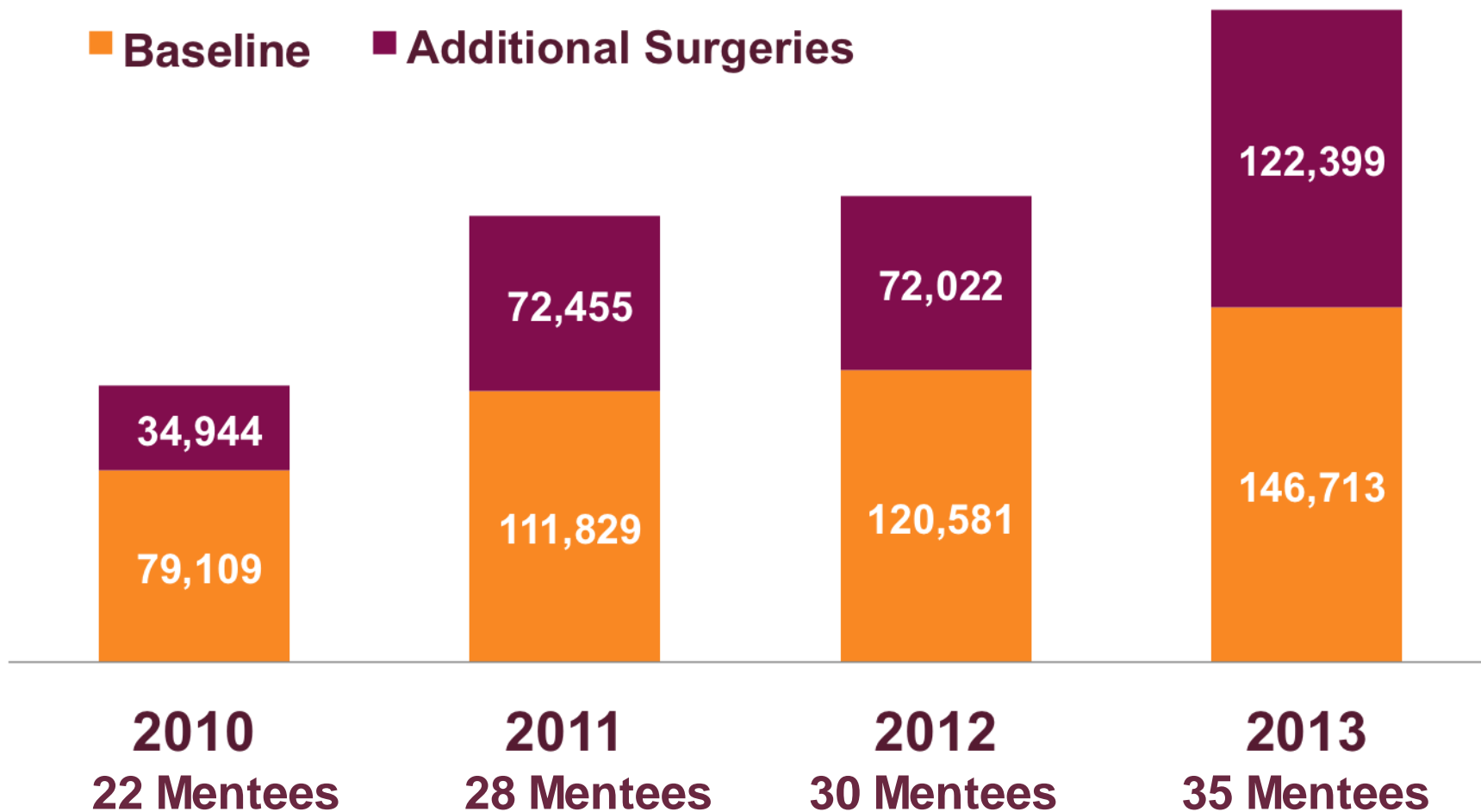
