A person blinks 15 times

per minute. That means

An average person blinks around 15 to 20 times each minute, 1,200 times an hour.





Chameleons can move their eyes in **two** different directions at the same time.


Dolphins sleep with one eye open.

Test what your eyes can do!

Our eyes are good at following an object. Even better at adjusting to head movements.

TEST IT. Keeping your head still, hold up your hand about 30cm (about a foot) away, and quickly move it back and forth. As fast as your eyes are, your fingers become blurry. Now keep your hand still and move your head back and forth. Amazingly, your fingers stay in focus!





How many times can you blink in a second?

TEST IT. The highest recorded is 5!

Your pupils change their sizes to allow just the right amount of light to enter your eye.

TEST IT. Go to a room and pull down your blinds with just enough light to look at your pupil in a mirror. Turn the lights on and there, you will see them shrinking to almost a dot.


