Seeing is so important that it uses up 50% of the brain!




The eye has over two million working parts.

A person blinks 15 times per minute. That means our eyes are closed for 10% of the day!









Your eyes can get sunburnt.




Dragonflies' eyes have up to 30,000 lenses helping them to see all the way around them.

Owls are the only birds that can see the color blue, and they can see a moving mouse more than 150 feet away (or 45 meters).




**Scorpions can** have as many as 12 eyes, but the box jellyfish has 24.


