

How to Request a Proclamation

What is a Proclamation?

A **Proclamation** is an official declaration made by a government official to bring attention to a specific issue or event.



Choose a Government Office

- Do you need a proclamation from your **city, county, or state**?
- Look up their website and find the proclamation request guidelines
 - Can be found under “Ceremonial” or “Forms”
 - If you can’t find it, contact the office directly

Submit Your Request

- Follow your city/county/state specific guidelines
- Typically, you will need the following:
 - Draft of the proclamation
 - Purpose of the proclamation
 - Date the proclamation is needed
 - A brief history of your organization
 - Contact Information



TIPS:

- Some officials may require the proclamation several weeks ahead of a meeting
- Check the office’s session schedule and follow up as needed
- Contact the office to confirm the receipt and status of your request
